MPP	2 Years	Largest and most versatile
MA Full Time	1 Year	For those with another graduate degree or 5+ years of work experience
MSCAPP	2 Years	Public Policy and Computer Science, some experience, strong academics
MACRM	15 Months	Very strong quant, PhD long-term goal
MA Part-time (EMP)	15 Months	For those working full-time, mid-career professionals. Not eligible for international student visa sponsorship



- Additional support staff oversee student life including student organizations and the mentor program.


Harris Student Organizations
