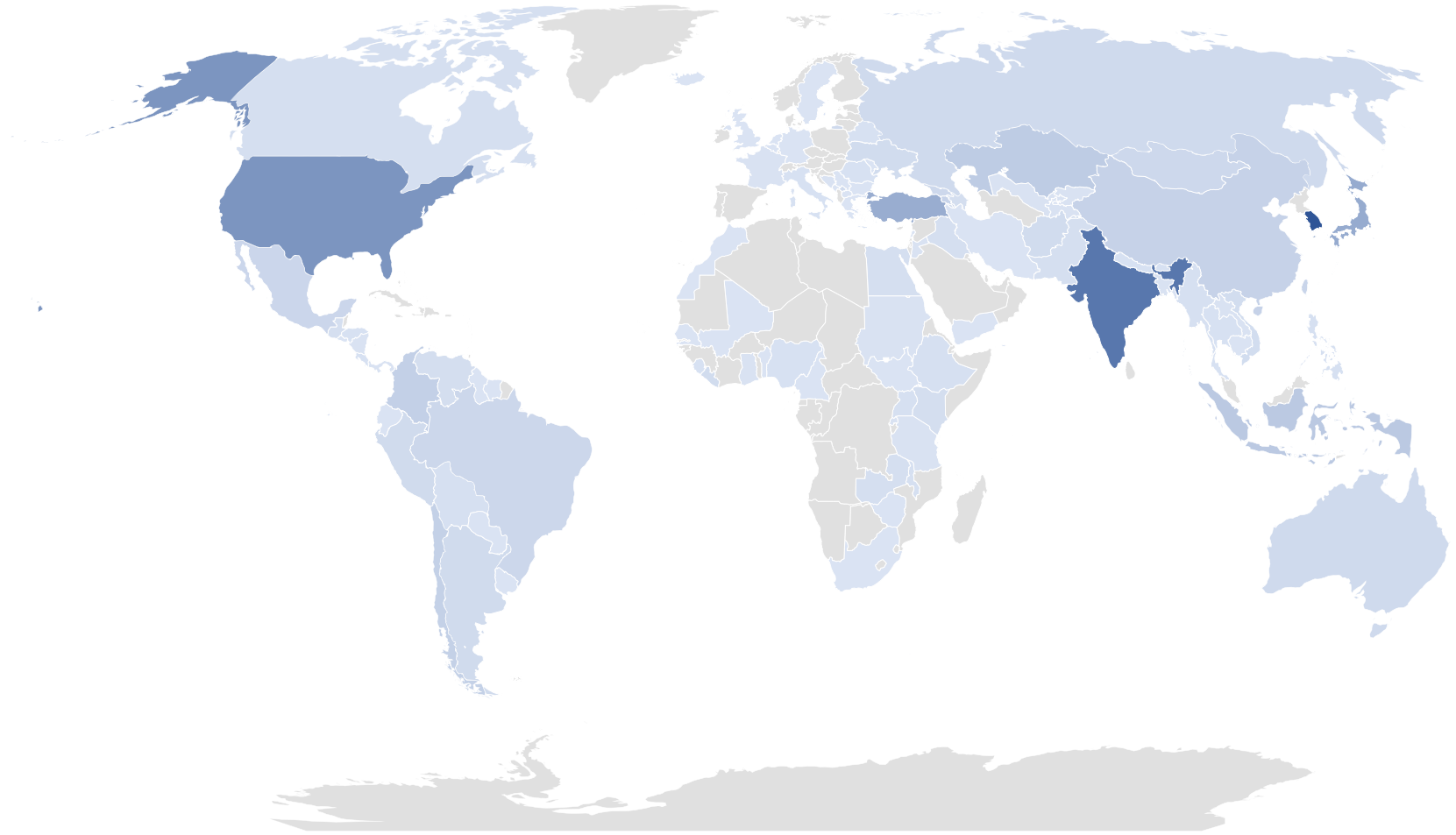





Employment Upon
