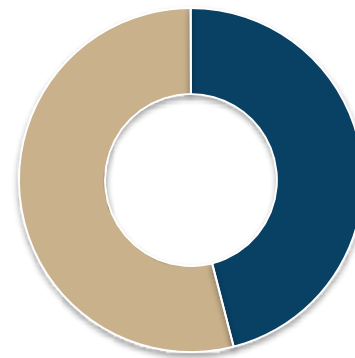

Admission Requirements

- ✦ BA/BS from a regionally accredited college or university
- ✦ Demonstrated quantitative aptitude
- ✦ GMAT/GRE
 - Not required for all applicants.
 - Speak with me for more information.
- ✦ English Language Requirement

Application Requirements

- ✦ Online application form & fee*
- ✦ GMAT/GRE scores
- ✦ All university-level transcripts (unofficial or official)
- ✦ Résumé
- ✦ Letter(s) of Recommendation
- ✦ Statement of purpose
- ✦ English language proficiency test (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS) for international students

International Student Admission Requirements

English Language Scores*

- TOEFL: 100 internet-based
- IELTS: Overall score of 7.0 w/ no individual score below 6.0
- PTE Academic: 68
- Duolingo: 120
- Must have been taken within the past two years

Exemptions available for:

- Those who hold a degree in which language of instruction was English, provided English is official language of country
