- Demonstrated quantitative aptitude
- GMAT/GRE
 - · Not required for all applicants.
 - Speak with me for more information.
- English Language Requirement

Application Requirements

- Online application form & fee*
- GMAT/GRE scores
- All university-level transcripts (unofficial or official)
- Résumé
- Letter(s) of Recommendation
- Statement of purpose
- English language proficiency test (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS) for international students

International Student Admission Requirements

English Language Scores*

TOEFL: 100 internet-based

IELTS: Overall score of 7.0 w/ no individual score below 6.0

PTE Academic: 68

Duolingo: 120

Must have been taken within the past two years

Exemptions available for:

- Those who hold a degree in which language of instruction was English, provided English is official language of country
- US accredited foreign schools
- Citizens of certain countries

Transcript Evaluation

- International transcripts should be submitted to an approved, accredited independent evaluation agency.
