- Ice breaker
- **Group discussion:** What guarantees do protesters receive when claiming their rights in the streets? What is the state's response to social unrest or legitimate protests? Why should the exercise of civil protest be guaranteed? How does it impact democracy and freedom?
- **Moderator(s):** 2 students will lead the discussion. Participants are encouraged to provide examples based on their countries situation.

## 11 April – LGBT Rights

- Keynote speaker: Special invited to present a case study of LGBT rights in Latin America.
- Students are encouraged to join the discussion with questions and to present the perspectives in their own countries or based on their own experiences.

## 25 April – Movie

- To be defined with the club members. Last meeting of the semester, feedback from students and brainstorming for next semester.
