Executive Master of Public Administration (EMPA)-KDI School

 - Tuition discounts in residential EMPA/EMIR and CAS degree programs
 - May apply for fall or Spring Semesters
 - Eligibility to transfer in 6 credits from KDI
 - Application and TOEFL waivers

- 30 credits required
 - 3 core courses
 - PAI 895 Managerial Leadership
 - PAI 897 Fundamentals of Policy Analysis
 - PAI 996 Master's Project Course
 - 5-7 elective courses (up to 2-4 from other departments)
 - Transfer 6 credits from KDI

 - 4-6 elective courses (up to 4 from other departments)
 - Optional transfer of 6 credits from KDI
- Offered in Syracuse and Washington, D.C.

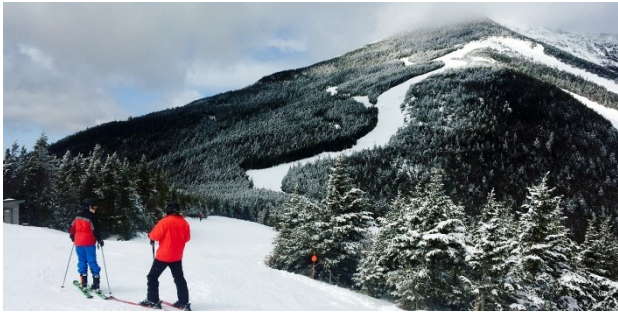
