

KDI-EJB SCHOLARS PROGRAM OPTIONS FOR 2020

Master of City and Regional Studies Degree (MCRS) (30 Credits)

This university **degree** is obtainable by all KDI students, and is the typically chosen path by the vast majority of those that apply. The degree offers a basic understanding of **planning** in a variety of areas, and then provides a chance to take several courses in a concentrated area, similar to a specialty. They include: Environmental and Physical Planning, Housing and Real Estate, Regional Planning and International Development, Transportation Policy and Planning, Urban and Community Development.

Master of Public Affairs and Politics (MPAP) (30 Credits)

This university **degree** is obtainable by all KDI students, and is newly open to students that apply. The degree offers a basic understanding of **public policy** in a variety of areas, and then provides a chance to take several courses in a concentrated area, similar to a specialty. They include: Budget and Finance, Economics, Education Environment Health, Labor and Workforce, Management, Methods, Non-Profit Management, Political Processes and Institutions, Social Policy and Women's Issues and Urban Policy and Community Development

Sample Program of Study #1

January-May: Take 3 courses and English Training (9 credits)
June-August: Take 1 course (3 credits)
September-December: Take 4 courses, transfer in 2 from KDI (12 credits)
Total: 30 credits (includes 6 credit transfer from KDI)

Sample Program of Study #2

January-May: Take 4 courses and English Training (12 credits)
June-August: Take 0 courses (0 credits)
September-December: Take 4 courses, transfer in 2 from KDI (12 credits)
Total: 30 credits (includes 6 credit transfer from KDI)
