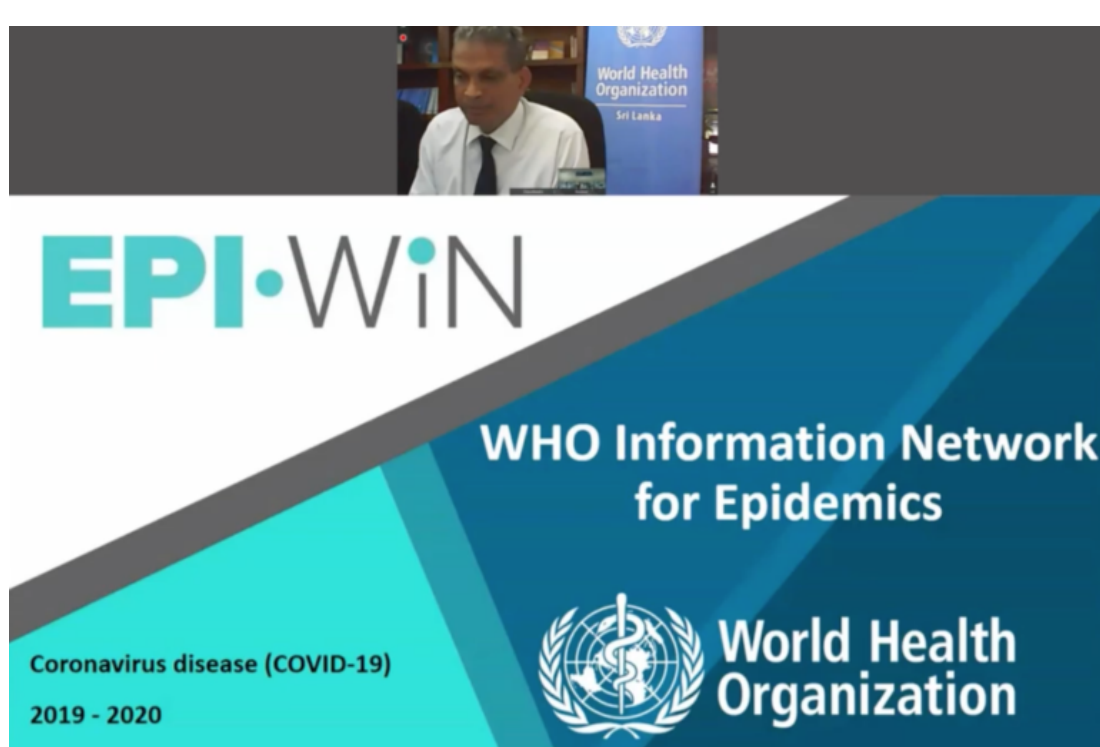
### Online Streaming at KDI School

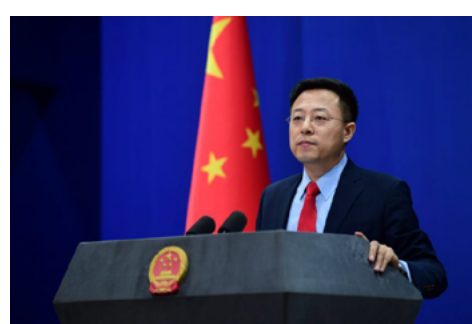


### From KDI School to Harvard: Se-in Kim, KDI School Class of 2018

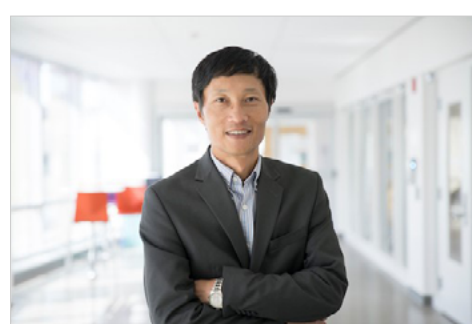
### KDI School Alumnus Now New Foreign Ministry Spokesperson
