

1. Minimum English requirement scores for entry

We prefer an 85 minimum TOEFL score. However, on a case-by-case basis, we may accept TOEFL scores as low as 83. Any applicants with a TOEFL score BELOW 85 should be advised to contact me directly before they apply so we can determine if their scores are acceptable to apply to our programs here.

We prefer a minimum 7.0 bandwidth on the IELTS. However, on a case-by-case basis, we may accept IELTS scores as low as 6.5 bandwidth. Any applicants with an IELTS score BELOW 7.0 bandwidth should be advised to contact me directly before they apply so we can determine if their scores are acceptable to apply to our programs here.

We require a minimum DuoLingo score of 115.

4. Can 20 years old and 23 years old children be accompanied as dependents?

The maximum age allowed for KDI Scholas to bring dependent children on their student visa is 21 years old. Dependent children who are OVER the age of 21 years-old are NOT allowed come as a dependent on the KDI Scholar's student visa.

So, the 20 years-old child can come to the US as a dependent on the KDI Scholar's student visa and they are permitted to enroll part time in an English language program at the Middlesex County Community College, if they are interested.
