Georgetown University: A Brief History

- Founded in 1789 by Father John Carroll
- Awarded Federal charter in 1815
- Civil War and the Blue & Gray
- Father Patrick Healy (GU President 1873-1882) the "second founder"
- First woman accepted in 1969
- First lay president 2001

Georgetown University: A Brief History

Nine schools are part of Georgetown University

- 1851 Medical School
- > 1870 Law Center (GULC)
- > 1903 School of Nursing & Health Studies
- > 1919 Walsh School of Foreign Service (SFS)
- > 1930s Graduate School of Arts & Sciences (GSAS)
- 1950s School of Continuing Studies (SCS)
- > 1957 McDonough School of Business (MSB)
- > 2013 McCourt School of Public Policy (McCourt)

The McCourt School

Georgetown Public Policy Institute (GPPI)

Founded in mid 1990s originally part of Government Department

- Master of Policy Management (MPM)—2001

- Master of Science in Data Science for Public Policy—2018
