Basic Qualifications:

- Excellent oral and written English skills. Please note that Korean fluency is *not* required for this position.
- Proficiency with Stata is required, though we are willing to consider someone who is proficient with R.
- Mature, self-directed individual with ability to balance multiple tasks and prioritize effectively to meet deadlines.
- Due to funding requirements, the candidate must be located in Korea and have a Korean bank account.
- Must have or be pursuing a masters or PhD.
